



Virtual Pet & People Walk



Looking for some kid friendly routes that allow the opportunity for the whole family to explore Maine's great outdoors? Look no further!

- Check out the [Royal River Hiking Trail](#) off of Depot Rd. in New Gloucester. The 1.7-mile North Loop trail takes you on some steep slopes in order to reach the Royal River. You will find more gentle slopes on the 1.5 mile South Loop. Both of these trails are accessible all year round, are great for hiking, & allow leashed dogs.
 - Visit [Mackworth Island](#), connected to Falmouth by a causeway at the mouth of the Presumpscot River. This 1.25 mile trail circles the island and offers excellent views of Casco Bay. The trail is mostly level and there are no steps or other major barriers to wheelchairs on the main loop.
- Enjoy sweeping shoreline views along [Ferry Beach State Park](#) in Saco. This 1.4 mile loop trail is good for all skill levels and dog friendly with the option to extend your visit with a walk or picnic on the beach!
